BACKSTAGE SECURITY

REHEARSALS

During rehearsals there will be no volunteers or staff assigned to monitor backstage activities. Dressing rooms will be available for dancers to change costumes & store belongings. All parents are responsible for monitoring, changing, and ensuring that his or her child is ready for rehearsal at the specified rehearsal time. There will be one Premiere staff member gathering classes from the dressing room prior to dress rehearsal. ALL DANCERS NEED TO BE IN THE DRESSING ROOM PRIOR TO HIS OR HER REHEARSAL. Between rehearsal times, dancers & families are welcome to come and go as they please. Dancers and families will also be allowed to watch rehearsals from the auditorium.

RECITAL

All dancers will need to check-in at the dancer check-in table with an adult prior to his or her recital. At the check-in table, one adult per child will receive a "backstage pass" bracelet. This bracelet will have his or her child's name on it and allow access backstage before and after the recital. This bracelet does not allow access during the show. During the show, Premiere volunteers will be in charge of monitoring, changing, and ensuring backstage safety. After the show has concluded, dancers must be picked

up backstage by the parent with the "backstage pass". Dancers will NOT be dismissed by Premiere volunteers until the "backstage pass" with the dancer's name on it is presented.

DRESSING ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Dressing Room assignments will be given at check in on the day of your dancer's recital. There will be signs posted directing each dancer to their assigned room. If your dancer is not in the correct dressing room, it will be very hard for our backstage staff to locate them for their performance.

HAIR / MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS

HAIR

All female dancers will be asked to wear their hair in a low middle ballet bun. This bun should be parted above the right eye and secured very tightly with hair ties, bobby pins and hairspray.

MAKEUP

All female dancers, with the exception of Creative Concepts, should wear "stage makeup". This includes: eyeshadow (any neutral, dark color), black eyeliner, black mascara, pink blush, and dark red lipstick.

TICKET SALES

Recital tickets will be available for purchase to our parents through the Parent Portal starting May 1st. All recital tickets will be \$5. Ticket costs will be due at the time of purchase. There will be no returning or exchanging tickets after tickets have been purchased. There will be no limit to the amount of tickets each parent is able to purchase.

Ticket sales will open to the general public on June 1st and be available through a link that will be emailed to our families and posted on our website & social media.

RECITAL T-SHIRTS

Recital T-shirts will be available to order. There is an order form inside of this packet. Please fill this out at your earliest convenience and return your order form and payment to the front desk. Orders are due by April 2nd. The design of the t-shirts is shown on the order form. Each t-shirt will have all participants' names listed.

RECITAL DVDS

Following the conclusion of the recital weekend, there will be DVDs available for purchase through Mr. Video Productions. DVDs can be ordered online at mrvideoonline.com when you search #903772. Prices will be as follows - \$35 for digital downloads & \$40 for DVDs mailed to your home.

VOLUNTEER PARENTS

In order for our show to run smoothly, we will need one volunteer per class. If you would like to sign up for this, please see the front desk or send us an email with the show and time that you are interested in helping with. Volunteer parents would be in charge of keeping the dancers occupied, helping with costume changes, sending the students to line up in the appropriate costume at the correct time, and maintaining organization & security inside of the dressing rooms.

- BRING ALL COSTUMES, SHOES, MAKEUP, HAIR SUPPLIES, ETC...
- BLANKET FOR DANCERS TO SIT ON IN DRESSING ROOM
- SNACKS FOR THE DRESSING ROOMS (DANCERS WILL BE PROVIDED WITH ACTIVITIES WHILE THEY WAIT BACKSTAGE)

COSTUME NOTES

- MALE DANCERS Male dancers will not wear tights.
- **CREATIVE CONCEPTS** All classes will not wear tights or shoes with their costumes. Hairpieces should be worn above the bun on the dancer's right side.
- **DISCOVER DANCE** All classes will wear the same costume for both ballet & tap. All hairpieces should be worn above the bun on the dancer's right side. Tan tights will be worn for both dances.
- **KINDERCOMBO** All hair pieces should be worn above the bun on the dancer's right side. Tan tights will be worn for both dances.
 - Monday @ 3:30p Black / Pink Tutu (Ballet), Pink Half-Skirt (Tap)
 - Monday @ 5:00p White Tutu (Ballet), Red Half-Tutu (Tap)

- Tuesday @ 4:30p White Tutu (Ballet), Red Half-Tutu (Tap)
- Wednesday @ 10:15a Blue Tutu (Ballet), Purple Fringe Skirt (Tap)
- Wednesday @ 5:45p Light Blue Tutu (Ballet), Blue / Pink Skirt (Tap)
- Wednesday @ 6:30p Yellow Tutu (Ballet), No Skirt (Tap)
- o Thursday @ 5:00p Yellow Tutu (Ballet), No Skirt (Tap)
- Thursday @ 6:30p Black / Pink Tutu (Ballet), Pink Half-Skirt (Tap)
- **INTERMEDIATE PROGRESSION** All hair pieces should be worn above the bun on the dancer's right side. Tan tights will be worn for both dances.
 - o Tuesday @ 6:00p Burgundy/Blue Tutu (Ballet), Burgundy Fringe Skirt (Tap)
 - o Thursday @ 4:45p Burgundy/Blue Tutu (Ballet), Burgundy Fringe Skirt (Tap)
- TAP I-IV Tan tights will be worn.
 - o Tap I Hairpiece should NOT be worn. Wristbands will be worn.
 - o Tap II Hat should be worn directly on top of head.
- JAZZ I-IV Tan tights will be worn.
 - Jazz I Hairpiece should be worn above the bun on the dancer's right side.
- LYRICAL I & II Tan tights will be worn folded up to the ankles.
 - Lyrical I Hairpieces should be worn above the bun on the dancer's right side.
- CONTEMPORARY Tan tights will be worn folded up to the ankles.
- ACRO (Introductory, Beginner, Intermediate, & Advanced) All acro classes will wear tan tights folded up to the ankles with bare feet.
 - Introductory Acro Hairpieces should be worn directly above the bun.
 - Beginner Acro Hairpieces should be worn directly above the bun.
 - Advanced Acro Hairpieces should NOT be worn.
- **HIP HOP** Tan tights will be worn. No socks should be worn over the tights unless specified. Shoes should be worn.
 - o Introductory Hip Hop Hairpieces should be worn directly above the bun.
 - Hip Hop I (Tuesday @ 7:15p) Hairpieces should be worn directly above the bun. Gloves should be worn.
 - Hip Hop I (Wednesday @ 5:15p) Bandanas should be worn. Flannel should be unbuttoned. Socks should be worn.
 - Hip Hop II (Tuesday @ 5:30p & Wednesday @ 7:30p) Hairpieces should not be worn. Jackets should be zipped ¾ up.
 - Hip Hop III/IV Hats should NOT be worn.

Dancer's should not wear any undergarments with their costumes.
